White Wines

FRANCE

Duc de Chapelle ~ Blanc Colombard Chardonnay 2005/06
A crisp, fresh dryish wine from south west France **£11.50**

Sancerre ~ Domaine Morin 2005 **£26.00**
Firmly structured after extended aging on the lees. Demonstrates an extra blackcurrant richness and a complex zesty finish.

Petit Chablis ~ Domaine Gautheron 2005 **£22.00**
True mineral and floral character and distinct fresh acidity of Chablis. It is fresh and vibrant with rich apple and mineral flavour that lasts well on the finish.

SPAIN

Rioja Blanco – Marqués de Caceres 2005 **£14.00**
Attractive pale straw colour with a fresh and floral bouquet. Delicious light elegant summer fruits in the mouth are balanced with a sweet citrusy twist and full length.

ITALY

Pinot Grigio ~ San Antonio, Veneto 2005/06 **£14.00**
This very fashionable white has a touch of chardonnay added to give an extra weight and complexity. The aroma is delicate and zingy, on the taste buds. There are hints of nuts and lovely ripe fruit flavours with fresh, crisp acidity.

NEW ZEALAND

Sauvignon Blanc ~ Wairau River, Marlborough 2005/06
£19.50

The 2005 is an acclaimed Sauvignon Blanc, winning gold at the Air NZ awards. It is a classic expression of the dry, gooseberry, grass and passion fruit style of Sauvignon that has made Marlborough world famous.

SOUTH AFRICA

Sauvignon Colombar 'John B' ~Rietvallei, Robertson 2005 **£13.00**
The wine has a lovely floral bouquet with intense fruit flavours on the palate and a well balanced acidity makes for a zesty long after taste.

Chenin Blanc ~ Tulbagh Ridge 2005 **£16.00**
The bouquet has hints of vanilla and an almost oaky character. Enticing peach apricot and lemon lead into a fruity mouthful where more tropical flavours add intensity.

ROSE WINE

Pinot Grigio 'Ramato' ~ Il Barco Veneto (Italy) **£14.50**
A delicate Salmon Pink Rose with a perfumed aroma of peach and rose petals and soft, real fruit flavours on the palate. It is dry and well balanced.

Red Wines

FRANCE

Duc du Chapelle ~ Rouge Cabernet Merlot 2005/06 **£11.50**
A medium bodied, soft fruity red from south west France

Special Reserve Claret ~ Bordeaux Superieur 2004/05 **£16.25**
This has a deep ruby colour, an intense and vigorous bouquet and firm ripe harmonious flavours with a long finish

Brouilly ~ 'Vielles Vignes', Domaine Dubost 2005 **£25.00**
Ripe with red fruits and rounded tannins. This Cuvee Is the preferred choice of many of France's Michelin starred restaurateurs, combining particularly well with white meats, paté and duck dishes.

SPAIN

Rioja Tinto ~ Don Placero 2005 **£15.00**
Made from 60% Tempranillo grapes with 40% Garnacha, the classic native red varieties of Rioja, which exhibit sweet plum and raspberry finishing with cedar and vanilla on the palate

Rioja Reserva ~Bodegas Azabache 2001 **£24.00**
This excellent Rioja is made in the traditional style having been aged for 3 years in oak and bottle before release and exhibits intense fruits with hints of vanilla and a soft rounded palate.

AUSTRALIA

Grenach Mourvedre Shiraz ~ Geoff Merrill 2002 **£17.00**
The colour is deep red with youthful purple lines. The aroma shows intense oriental pepper and spice combined with rich berry fruit characters.

SOUTH AFRICA

Cabernet Tinto Barocca 'John B', Rietvallei, Roberston 2004 **£13.00**
A wine with lots of attractive fruit on the nose and a hint of spiciness on the palate. It is smooth and well balanced with a touch of toastiness and a lingering aftertaste

Pinotage ~Tulbagh Ridge 2004 **£17.00**
Fragrant and supple with sweet flavours of red berries and summer fruits. Its soft supple character and delicate rounded tannins allow easy drinking.

CHILE

Merlot ~ La Playa, Colchagua Valley 2004 **£15.00**
Deep violet red, lovely aromas of blackberries, cherries and plums, concentrated fruit and a long delicious flavour.

DESSERT WINE

Orange Muscat & Flora ~ Brown Brothers **£13.75**
Milawa, Victoria (Australia) (1/2 bottle)
This blend of two sweet and distinctly perfumed Muscat grape varieties is one of Australia's great dessert wines with delicious aromas of orange marmalade balanced with hints of citrus.

Sparkling Wines and Champagnes

Mont Marçal ~ Cava Brut Reserva Penedes (Spain) **£17.00**
Aged for 18 months to add fresh yeasty aromas to ripe apple and creamy flavours, giving exceptional balance.

Lindauer ~ Brut (New Zealand) NV **£22.00**
Light Golden in colour with fresh yeasty aromas complementing the fruitiness of the wine. Fresh on the palate with pleasant natural acidity.

Lanson ~ Brut Black Label NV **£34.00**
A bouquet of ripe fruit and citrus fruit create a sensation of fullness, fruitiness and lightness.

Lanson ~ Rose **£42.00**
A beautiful Rose with pure colour and pale salmon touches. On the palate it is tender, well rounded and fresh with a harmonious balance and good length on the finish.
