Conditions Of The Competition

Handicap Limit – 5

The Competition is a 36 holes scratch stroke play competition.

The Morning round will be played over the Old Course and the Afternoon round will be played over the New Course. Both rounds will be qualifying rounds for handicap purposes. Prizes will be awarded to the top ten 36-hole scores and for the best Morning and Afternoon rounds.

No competitor may win more than one prize.

In the event of a tie, the result will be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or final holes, as necessary.

Entries

- Entries must be made on the Entry Form and be accompanied by the Entry Fee of £50.00 inclusive of morning coffee, ploughman's lunch and afternoon tea.

The number of entries is restricted to 72 and handicaps will be taken into account for qualification purposes.

Entries close at Close of Business on Friday 23rd April 2010

The draw will be made on Monday, 26th April and a copy will be sent to each player as soon as possible.

No refunds will be given after the draw has been made unless substitutes can be found.
